



Mighty mall flexes its muscle

The Grove Mall of Namibia, the largest shopping centre ever to be developed in the country and spanning some 55 000m² in Windhoek, has opened its doors.

Located within the Hilltop mixed-use estate in Kleine Kuppe, the R1-billion mall was jointly developed by Atterbury Property Holdings and JSE-listed Attacq, and local Namibian partners The Frontier Property Trust and Demushuwa Property Developer.

“The Mall of Namibia is the country’s first regional shopping centre. With more than 120 retail stores, restaurants and service outlets, 28 of which are new to Namibia, the mall brings a new experience to the people of Namibia,” said Cobus van Heerden, of Atterbury Property.

The Grove Mall of Namibia was designed by Boogertman & Partners along with Howard & Chamberlain architects.
